Major Duties and Responsibilities: Instructional Strategies:

- Prepare lessons that reflect accommodations for differences in student learning styles.
- Conduct assessment of student learning styles and use results to plan instructional activities. Work with other staff members to determine instructional goals, objectives, and methods.
- Plan and supervise assignments of teacher aide(s) and volunteer(s).

Student Growth and Development:
